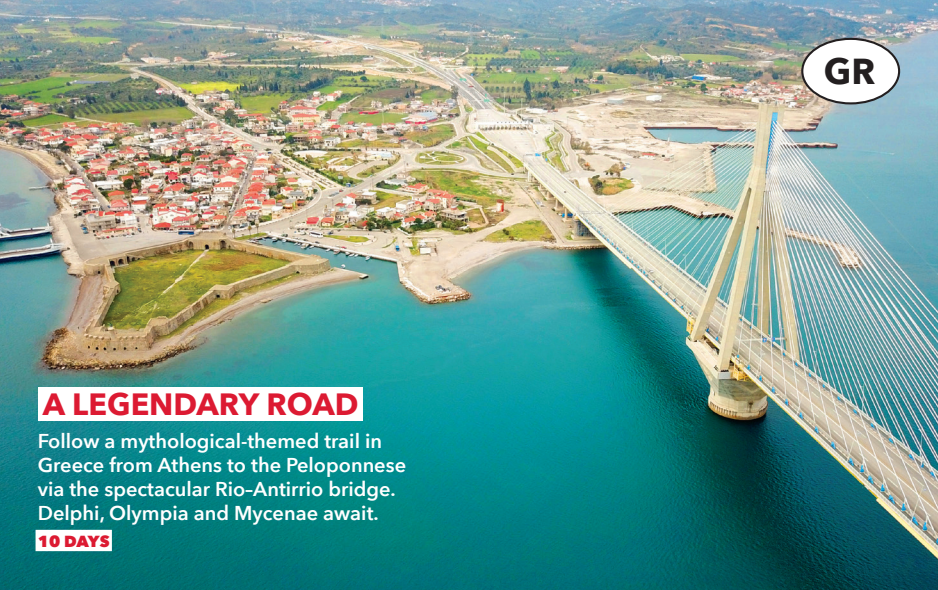

MEET BIG DADDY

Namibia is one of the world's last great wilderness countries. Aim for the Namib desert at Sossusvlei, home to some of the highest sand dunes in the world. The tallest in this area, some 325m in height, is known as Big Daddy.

ONE-WAY WILDERNESS

Malaysia's colonial-era hill station Fraser's Hill lies 105km north of Kuala Lumpur. Built on seven jungle-clad hills, it is reached via a scenic 8km single track road, open to traffic travelling in one direction only, but switching directions every hour.

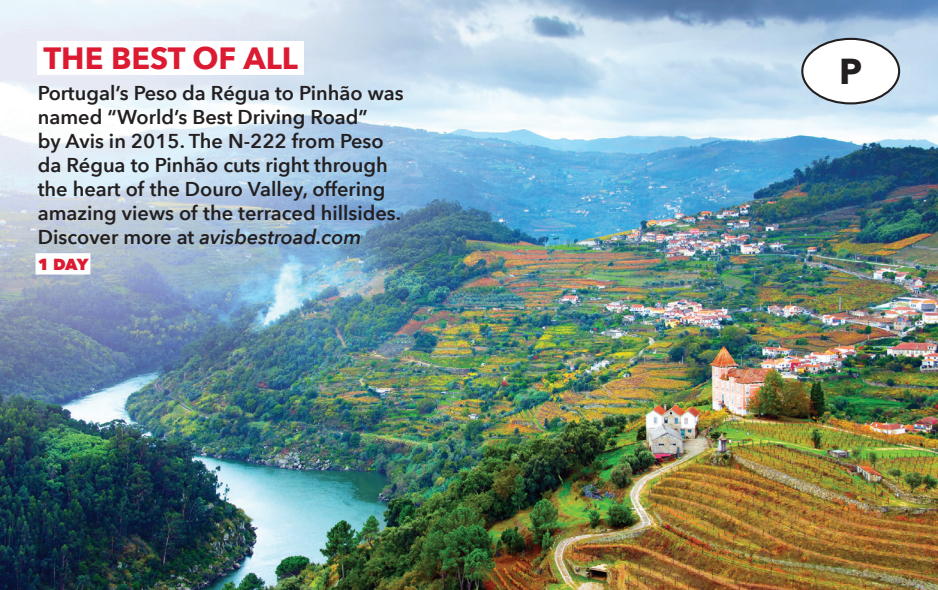

SEVEN MILE BRIDGE

Cruise down Florida's 240km US Route 1 from Miami to Key West, taking the "Overseas Highway" linking the keys (from Spanish cayo for "islet"). The most spectacular section is the Seven Mile Bridge, with the Gulf of Mexico to your right and the Atlantic to your left.
